Establishes provisions relating to genetically modified material. Requires a biotech company that sells any genetically modified animal, genetically modified plant, or genetically modified seed that the biotechnology company knows, or has reason to believe, will be used to produce an agricultural commodity to provide written notice to the purchaser that fully and clearly discloses the possible legal and environmental risks that the use of the genetically modified animal, genetically modified plant, or genetically modified seed may pose to the purchaser. Allows the chairperson of the board of

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agriculture to bring an action to recover a civil penalty against any person for violation.

Amends provisions relating to committee on weights. Provides that the committee on weights may create a list of factors that will be weighted including student characteristics, enrollment trends and optimal student teacher ratios and determine the optional student teacher ratio for each grade level. Requires the committee to incorporate weights to account for necessary special education teachers and special education support staff; weights to account for anticipated enrollment increases and associated facility concerns; and weights representing the optimal student teacher ratio at each grade level. -- SB0547

RELATING TO MARIJUANA.

Introduced by: English J, Ruderman R, Rhoads K, Ihara L

Establishes the legalization of marijuana for personal use law. Provides that personal use of marijuana (cannabis) shall not be the basis for arrest, seizure, or forfeiture of assets; possession, use, display, purchase, transfer or transporting marijuana accessories or marijuana paraphernalia for personal use shall be immune from criminal prosecution; the possession, growing, processing, or transporting of not more than 6 marijuana plants and possession of the marijuana produced by the plants on the premises where the plants are grown shall not be subject to criminal prosecution provided that the growing takes place in a secure space, the plants are not conducted openly or publicly, and is not made available for sale; the transfer of 1 ounce or less of marijuana with or without remuneration to a person who is 21 years of age or older is permitted. Establishes lawful operation of marijuana establishments and license requirements. Provides that an employer is not required to permit or accommodate the use, consumption, possession, transfer, display, transportation, sale, or growing of marijuana in the workplace and allows an employer to have policies restricting the use of marijuana by employees. Provides that this law shall not be construed to limit any privileges or rights of a medical marijuana qualifying patient, primary caregiver, or registered entity under medical use of marijuana law. Subjects marijuana establishment to income taxes and general excise taxes. Establishes provisions relating to legalization of marijuana under offenses against public health and morals law. Exempts marijuana from arrest, prosecution, and criminal culpability. -- SB0548

Amends provisions relating to weighted student formula. Provides that a remote school and other schools designated by the committee on weights shall not be allocated operating funds using the weighted student formula and shall instead be allocated operating funds by categorical allotments that guarantee the funding of a minimum number of instructional positions to ensure that at least minimum course requirements are maintained. Defines remote school to mean any public high school except public charter high school, located at least a 1 hour drive away from the next nearest public high school; or located on the island of Lanai, Molokai, or Niihau; provided that if a high school is combined with an elementary, middle, intermediate, or other lower level of schooling, that the entire school shall be deemed a high school. -- SB0549

Prohibits a person to plant a genetically engineered seed or plant part, the genetically engineered properties of which are capable of release to an offspring in an open field in this State. Authorizes the chairperson of the board of agriculture to grant exceptions. -- SB0550

Establishes provisions relating to genetically engineered material; labeling requirement. Prohibits the sale of food or raw agricultural commodity that contains a genetically engineered material, or was produced with a genetically engineered material in the State

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unless it bears a label that provides a disclosure notice in bold face print not less than 10 point type. Exempts food served in restaurants or other establishment in which food is served for immediate human consumption; processed and prepared primarily in a retail establishment and is ready for human consumption, or a medical food. Establishes fines.

Requires the department of agriculture to take precautionary measures to anticipate, prevent, or minimize the adverse effects of biotechnology and genetic engineering. Provides that where there are threats of serious or irreversible damage, lack of full scientific certainty should not be used as a reason for postponing the application of precautionary measures, taking into account that policies and measures should be at the lowest reasonable cost, to achieve policies and measures should take into account different socioeconomic contexts, be comprehensive, cover all relevant sources, and comprise all agricultural sectors. -- SB0552

Establishes provisions relating to remote schools categorical funding. Defines remote school to mean any public high school except public charter high school, located at least a 1 hour drive away from the next nearest public high school or located on the island of Lanai, Molokai, or Niihau; provided that if a high school is combined with an elementary, middle, intermediate, or other lower level of schooling, that the entire school shall be deemed a high school. Provides that subject to legislative appropriations, a remote school may receive supplemental categorical funding to support additional instructional and support staff and that any supplemental categorical funding provided to a remote school shall be in addition to the allocation determined under the weighted student formula that is made to the remote school.
