- SB0005 RELATING TO HOUSING SAVINGS ACCOUNTS.
Introduced by: Chang S, English J, Keith-Agaran G, Keohokalole J, Lee C, Misalucha B
Establishes the housing savings account law. Establishes provisions relating to the housing savings account system that shall have the powers and privileges of a corporation and may sue or be sued, transact all of its business, invest all of its funds, and hold all of its cash, securities, and other property. Provides that the general administration and responsibility for the proper operation of the system and for making effective the provisions of this law are vested in the board. Establishes within the department of budget and finance the housing savings account board. Requires the board to consist of 8 members and the director of finance shall serve as chairperson. Requires each employer in the State to offer to its employees the opportunity to contribute to a housing savings account through payroll deduction. Allows an employer in the State to match an employee's contribution into each employee's account. Provides that funds contributed into an account shall not be exempt from income tax law and shall not receive any additional tax benefits. Allows funds contributed into an account to be used for any purpose, including but not limited to downpayments; mortgage payments; rent; or security deposits. Allows an employee to withdraw funds from their account at any time without any penalty. Establishes provisions relating to enrollment and employee contributions. -- SB0005

- SB0065 RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.
Introduced by: Baker R, Chang S, English J, Keith-Agaran G, Keohokalole J
Amends provisions relating to direct shipment of wine by wineries by changing it to direct shipment of liquor by producers. Adds class 14 to a general excise tax license from the department of taxation and changes the term from wine to liquor. Repeals that allows the holder of a direct liquor shipper permit to sell and annually ship liquor to no more than 6, 9 liter cases of wine per household. Adds that allows the holder of a class 14 license to manufacture liquor under provisions relating to licenses, classes to renew a direct liquor shipper permit concurrently with the class 14, class 16, or class 18 license by complying with all applicable laws and paying all required fees. Requires rather than allows each county to adopt rules and regulation necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this provision; provided that any rulemaking shall not delay the commencement of the direct shipment of liquor on the effective date of this Act. Allows the holder of a direct liquor shipper permit to ship to and from any county or state where properly licensed and shall ensure that all reciprocal shipping license requirements are met in the receiving county or state.
